


Wes Sam-Bruce | About the artist



Wes Sam-Bruce walks a tricky tightrope as a maker. Through his format-bending practice, he is both an artist and an art educator, a writer of poetry, a sculptor, a community program organizer, a filmmaker etc. The majority of his creative energy goes towards large-scale, exploratory installations and exhibitions with museums that act as worlds within the world. Blending fact and fiction and capturing the imagination of adults and children, these installations are often partnered with children's museums and education departments; creating submersive spaces that act as living metaphors and conjure multisensory connections that are open to anyone through the power of creation, play, and wonder. In the artist's own words, these spaces nurture "the insightful, imaginative, and adaptable capacity to see into hidden and often unseen things and to craft innovative experiences that are deeply engaging, exploratory in nature, expansive in ideation, and wildly creative."

Because his work primarily exists at large scales in museums, this is a rare opportunity to take a piece of one of his exhibitions home with you. For this month's focus, we have jointly selected a group of small works from Wes that echo the qualities and visuals of his installations, at a more intimate scale.
