Brooklyn based artist, Scott Albrecht, will present his exhibition 'Where The Edges Meet' as the inaugural exhibition for the new Andenken permanent gallery space called 'The Holdout'.

In anticipation of the exhibition, Scott has embarked on a short two week residency at The Holdout which began in mid-April. We celebrate the conclusion of the residency with the exhibition reception.

The exhibition is presented by Andenken in tandem with The Jaunt of Copenhagen.

#### **About the Artist**

Scott Albrecht was born in 1983 in New Brunswich, NJ and currently lives in Brooklyn, NY. In 2003, he received a degree in graphic design from the Art Institute of Philadelphia. Perhaps best known for his cut, painted and assembled wood pieces, he also works in a variety of other mediums including steel, collage and pen and ink on paper, panel, sculptures and murals. His work has been published and exhibited internationally. Scott has collaborated with a number of clients including Paypal, the Brooklyn Academy of Music, Rag and Bone, Vans and others.

'Within my work, a large part of my approach involves abstracting typography and exploring an idea in a more visual or physical way. Each work is informed by letters and characters from an underlying message within the piece. It's intentional that these works alter the relationship the viewer has with its legibility in an attempt to shift from simply reading and consuming a message to experiencing and considering an idea through a more visual language.' - Scott Albrecht

#### **About The Holdout**

In April of 2018 we purchased an old farmhouse and apple orchard in Areeiro, Alcobaça in the Silver Coast region of Portugal, and dubbed it 'The Holdout'. The Holdout is a hybrid exhibition space, visiting artist studio, and private residence designed in tandem with architect CS Laurenolda of Alcobaça

The Holdout is set in a truly gorgeous Portuguese landscape, of quaint farms, and fantastic coastlines. She's nested in a place that our digital age hasn't yet overwhelmed, and in many ways this land of plenty is quietly untouched. At the same time we remain paired to our rascally pal the internet as a way to share and connect what we've found here. We reach out from here to bridge to our larger world. The Holdout is our intimate addition to the long tradition of the considered contemporary art space and it is a sanctuary for artists, ourselves, family, friends, patrons, and neighbours.

#### **About The Jaunt**

The Jaunt is a timely and excellently curated ongoing art project. Once a month The Jaunt sends an emerging or established artist somewhere they've never been to do some travel blogging and get inspired by a fresh location. These trips (Scott's is trip number 54) are made possible through a prerelease 'blind' print sale. Patrons wishing to support an artist on their Jaunt can buy a limited edition screen print or small sculptural piece in advance of the journey, and then will be pleasantly rewarded a few weeks after the trip with a piece uniquely inspired by the Artist's adventure. 'Where The Edges Meet' Series Explorations

For his exhibition 'Where The Edges Meet' Scott has created 3 new small series of pieces inspired by his time in Portugal.

A set of ink paintings on found flat stone (collected from the rock quarry nearby in Parque Natural das Serras de Aire e Candeeiros).

A set of small original paintings on paper inspired by the colour palettes of our natural Portuguese landscape and architecture.

A set of wire assemblages on panel highlighting Scott's confident line work in a brand new medium for the artist.

All three of these new series feature deeper exploration into the artist's constant alliance with typography. For these series Scott has used Portuguese language and linguistic expressions as the foundation for the work for each piece. Some of the works are in Portuguese

Works from all three of these original series, along with a handful of offerings from Scott's more known style of highly crafted wood typography paintings are available in this exhibition preview and catalogue.





When we first found The Holdout, she was in dire need of some loving touch.


When we began, The Holdout hadn't been occupied in 20 years, it had half a roof, and no floor. It had no running water and no power, but it did have a barn owl living in it.


We've spent the last 13 months rehabilitating The Holdout and Scott's exhibition 'Where The Edges Meet' is the starting line for a new life for this old building.

From what it was when we found it, to what it The Holdout is now with the prospect of a cool future for the community of artists and patrons we love ...we are just so excited to bring this space to a new life.








The Holdout Gallery Space currently has 3 main exhibition walls:


Wall 1 is 770cm (303" approx.) Wall 2 is 215cm (84.65" approx.) Wall 3 is 270cm (106.3" approx.)

Walls are very tall, approx 600 cm (236" approx.) + Vaulted Ceiling





































#### The Jaunt #54
